Moderna Vaccine Clinic at Talent Elementary School

TALENT, ORE. (Apr. 27, 2021) —

On Saturday, May 8, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Rogue Community Health and Phoenix-Talent Schools will offer a Moderna vaccine clinic for Hispanic community members 18 and older.

The clinic will take place in the Talent Elementary School gym, located at 307 Wagner Creek Rd, and pre-registration is required.

"Our goal is to provide vaccine access in a place that is familiar and comfortable for our students' families, and the entire community in Phoenix and Talent," says Jake Patoski, Phoenix-Talent Schools Communications Specialist.

located at the Shops at Exit 24. SO Health-E will have bilingual staff there assisting with registration from 12-6 p.m. Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays leading up to the event.

The vaccine will be offered at no cost. Participants who have insurance need to bring their insurance card. All participants need to bring a form of identification.

Once registered, participants will receive a text message or a call with their appointment time, based on their selected preference. Participants can park at Talent Elementary School, Talent Middle School or nearby street parking.
