WELCOME TO THE ROGUE WAY TO HEALTH

A School-Based Health Center (SBHC) is a health clinic that provides physical, behavioral health and preventive services for students in a school setting. All enrolled students are eligible for appointments.

CLINIC SERVICES

Our priority is to get to know you and your health care needs. We offer a wide variety of services to meet your wellness goals.

- Diagnoses and treatment of urgent and non-urgent illness
- Routine physical exams, including sports physicals
- Vision, dental and blood pressure screenings
- Dental health screening and referral for dental care
- Treatment of minor injuries
- Prescription medications
- Immunizations
- Behavioral health screenings
- Health education
- Oregon Health Plan (OHP) enrollment assistance
