# Welcome to the Rogue Way to Health

Rogue Community Health's school-based health centers (SBHCs) are health clinics embedded in schools throughout the Rogue Valley that provide healthcare and preventative services for physical, behavioral, and dental well-being. This includes support and referrals for needs around the social determinants of health. All enrolled students are eligible for appointments, regardless of insurance status or ability to pay. Siblings of enrolled students can also be seen for acute care.

## **Clinic Services**

Our priority is to get to know you and your health care needs. We offer a wide variety of services to meet your wellness goals.

- Diagnoses and treatment of urgent and non-urgent illness
- Routine physical exams, including sports physicals
- Vision and blood pressure screenings
- Dental services including oral education, assessments, sealants, and fluoride treatment
- · Treatment of minor injuries
- Prescription medications
- Immunizations
- Behavioral health screenings & counseling
- · Health education
- Oregon Health Plan (OHP) enrollment assistance
- Referrals for social determinants of health services, such as food insecurities, transportation, etc.
- COVID-19 testing
